





The AIM Foundation was formed to provide funding for projects that improve the overall climate of patient safety, enhance the professionalism and skills of AIM member boards and their staff, and/or research problems that impact AIM member Boards.



Topics Eligible for Consideration

- Improving the overall climate of patient safety and the professionalism of executives, boards and staff;
- Special educational events or program enhancements that benefit AIM member boards, board executives and staff;
- Research requests that seek to solve problems impacting AIM member boards and board executives and staff;
- Partner with other foundations to carry out joint research or projects that improve patient health outcomes through enhanced board, executive and staff professionalism and skill building;
- Travel costs to and from AIM sponsored functions.
- Other –specify why a different focus is more important to your board than those listed above.





Examples

- Study of burnout in boards and staff
- Projects to enhance licensee participation in board matters
- Studies and recommendations for best practices for boards and staff
- Innovative projects to increase public awareness of boards and their role in regulation
- Travel and/or registration costs to AIM sponsored functions or other professional meetings that enhance the professionalism of executive directors and their staff;






Timelines

- In general applications are due:
 - April 1st

- October 1st
- There are two exceptions
 - Travel scholarship requests
 - ► Time sensitive projects
- Awards will be announced at
 - The AIM Annual Meeting in April
 - ► The AIM Fall Workshop in November
- > You will be notified by e-mail if unable to attend the meeting.





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What happens if my application is accepted?

- A check will be sent to the organization within 4 weeks
- Your organization must show proof that the funding provided was used for its intended purposes
- With the exception of travel scholarships, your organization must provide a professionally presented final report suitable for publishing and redistribution
- If requested and feasible, your organization agrees to present the project at an AIM meeting.





Q. Does all of work on the project need to be done in house?

A. No. When appropriate, awarded funds can be used to pay for work done by a third party.

Q. How are awards decided?

A. The AIM Foundation Board will review each application. A majority vote in favor of the project is required.



Data Sharing Criteria

Members may submit an IAMRA Data Sharing Form when:

1. A doctor has registered or attempted to register with fraudulent documents or provided other falsified information;

2. Action* has been taken and the doctor is thought to pose a flight risk to a jurisdiction, where, for example:

- i. they are known to have graduated from medical school;
- ii. they are known to have a registered address;
- iii. they are known to have a registration or a license to practice.

*Actions that may result in a doctor seeking to practice in another jurisdiction are generally those that adversely affect the doctor's ability to earn an income from medical practice, including, but not limited to:

- Suspension of license/registration for an indefinite or lengthy period;
- License revocation/cancellation of registration/stricken from a register;
- Significant restriction of scope of practice.
- 3. The doctor has been convicted of a serious crime.

4. A person who is not a registered/licensed doctor has been practicing medicine and is thought likely to seek to do so in another jurisdiction.

The MoU was signed by Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, Director General of the WHO, and Joan Simeon, Chair of IAMRA. The ceremony was also attended by IAMRA secretary Dr Humayun Chaudhry and Dr Jeffrey Carter, Chair of the Federation of State Medical Boards of the United States.
